Who would have known at 29 weeks pregnant we would welcome our tiny babies into this world? Jameson Wade was born at 11:55 pm weighing 2 lbs & 10oz. Aniston Greer was born at 11:57 pm weighing 2 lb & 11oz. We were very fortunate that our twins were born healthy, although they are so tiny. When I found out about the Anayat House through Dr. Thompson I felt such a wave of relief through this very stressful and emotional time. To have a nice, SAFE place to go to and be by our babies side was a blessing. We live over an hour and a half away and I could not imagine having to drive back and forth all the time. Everyone has been so accommodating and very nice during our stay. The Anayat House is my "safe haven." I couldn't be more appreciative for having been blessed to stay here. Thank you so very much!

Myah McDonald ended up in the hospital after a tragic accident in November. You may have heard this story from the local news about Myah and her boyfriend. They were star-gazing on top of a railcar and when the train began to move, they jumped. Tragically, Myah slipped and was caught under the train. While Myah was recovering at CHRISTUS St. Elizabeth, her mother, Regina McDonald stayed for 68 days at Anayat House to be near her daughter. Regina was able to rest at Anayat House between ICU visitations but could quickly return to the hospital if summoned by nurses.

Fours is a delicious, handmade caramel pecan confection dipped in dark chocolate. The name *Fours* originated 100 years ago reflecting a 4 shaped squiggle design which decorated the top of each candy square.

In 1916, a candy store in Roswell, New Mexico started making and offering the candy to their patrons. Due to demand, a mail order business was begun in the late 1920's resulting in over 2000 lbs being sold by mail. In the late 1950's, St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Roswell started making and selling the candy at their annual bazaar. While visiting family in Roswell in 1986, a St. Stephen's Episcopal Church parishioner learned of the candy project and brought it to Beaumont. *Fours* is hugely popular, always has a greater demand than can be met, and has been shipped to family and friends throughout the United States and several foreign countries.

2016 begins a joint *Fours* partnership between St. Stephen's Episcopal Church and Anayat House Medical Hospitality House. *Fours* is made by the loving hands of volunteers to benefit both entities in their service outreach to families in need.
